



Fact Sheet

The Department of Economics and Management of the University of Pisa has developed a three years undergraduate program, completely held in English and thought to be a one-way journey in the world of the international management for business and economics.

The central aim of the Bachelor of Science in Management for Business and Economics is to help young people to succeed in the business and economics field, providing professional knowledge of business management with an international overarching perspective, acquiring leadership skills and team building capabilities through the analysis of business cases and team work project.

The Bachelor is restricted access and the selection is based on the score obtained in one of the following tests: SAT, GMAT, ACT, TOLC-E, ENGLISH TOLC-E. The test must be done before completing the application procedure and the related score must be included in the application. Also Cambridge, IELTS, TOEFL certificate are considered.

Visa and Permit of Stay: Assistance provided by the Main international Office of the University international@unipi.it

Tuition Fees: € 2,452,00 Maximum.

Non-EU students can obtain a reduction of the tuition fees based on country of origin and/or on merit.

DSU Scholarship: Students can also apply for a scholarship provided by the DSU (**Regional "Right to Study" Programme**) and be granted tuition waivers or reductions based on their family income. The full scholarship includes free accommodation, meals and a monthly payment to cover extra expenses (sporting activities, books, etc.).

The annual call for applications for DSU scholarships is published in the month of July on the DSU Toscana website.

Foreign students (with income abroad) who wish to access the services offered by the DSU (Scholarship, Services



Scholarship, Grant for Disabled Students, Extraordinary Contribution, Subsidised Canteen Prices, etc.), must provide, along with their application, documentation relative to their economic situation at home. For further information: www.dsu.toscana.it

Fees and grants:

The "full yearly contribution" for standard students is € 2,530.00, educational, scientific and administrative services included.

The university contribution foresees 4 instalments. All students must pay the first instalment of € 356.00 at the time of enrolment, except for students applying for a DSU Toscana scholarship or having a disability of at least 66% or being disabled students.

The first instalment payment for students applying for a VISA must be made by 28 February 2025, with no late-payment extra charge.

Italian courses:

Intensive **Italian language courses** for international students are offered in September and October each year by the Interdepartmental Language Centre (CLI). Regular Italian courses are also offered during the year for different proficiency levels. Students are required to take an Entry Test (even absolute beginners) to establish their knowledge level when they start.
